Purpose:	This policy was initially adopted to specify the documents required for the registration of vehicles defined in section 14-163c of the Connecticut General Statutes at the time of initial registration to demonstrate compliance with section 14-163e of the Connecticut General Statutes. This policy is being revised to eliminate the requirement that the Federal Annual Inspection and Inspector Qualification forms be produced at the time of registration.		
Policy:	At the time of registration, registrants of vehicles defined in section 14-163c will no longer be required to submit a completed Federal Annual Inspection Report. State and federal laws do not require submission of this form to a motor vehicle agency at the time of registration.		
Legal Authority:	CGS sections 14-163c and 14-163e		
Procedure:	When registering any vehicle defined in section 14-163c, the Federal Annual Inspection/Inspector Qualification Forms will not be reviewed or collected.
